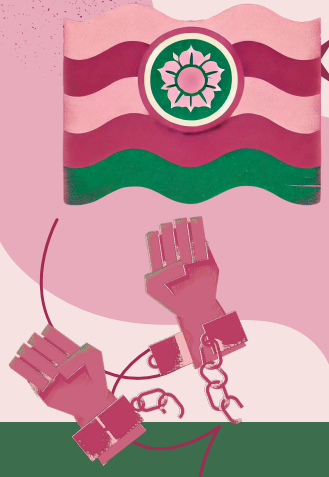




# LIBERTASIA

In Libertasia, polyandry (liberism) was adopted to boost population growth, given the shortage of women.



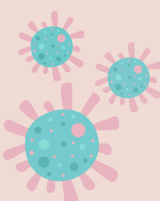
Despite their new start, femonia continued to cause miscarriages. After years of research, a cure was discovered using the country's unique flora.

The **femonia** disease initially caused many miscarriages, but after years of struggle, a cure was found, allowing women to safely bear children..

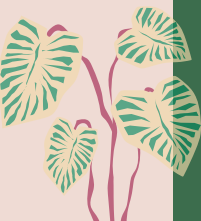


## FACTS
